

Event Rules:

- Please keep in mind that the event is being held within an active and operational airport – all rules must be adhered to for the safety of yourself, participants, event goers, aircraft and more!!!
- Alcohol is NOT allowed! You will be turned away or escorted out if alcohol is found.
- Barbeques and tents are NOT allowed! There is a general relief area available within the event.
- Staging for this event will begin at 0600 on Saturday June 6th, 2026. All vehicles MUST be parked and shut off by 8:30 AM. Event entrance opens at 9:00 AM.
- You must be present, have your vehicle signed in and inspected prior to entrance of the Airport fence. Any vehicles that arrive after 8:30 AM will not be allowed to enter!
- Please bring your driver's license for verification at sign in – if the license name does not match the application and insurance, you will not be allowed to enter! Applicant must be the driver of the vehicle.
- Only two people can enter the event in the registered vehicle.
- Your vehicle event registration must be placed in a visible area on your dashboard or front window. These are provided by the event staff.
- Your vehicle will be ushered by event staff to your designated parking spot. During the event, you will have the opportunity to take a photo with the P-51 Mustang and your vehicle – you must always follow the guidance of the event staff for safety!
- Once your vehicle is parked, you will have TWO opportunities to remove your vehicle from the event area – once at noon when the aircraft departs for its performance and at 3 PM when the event is over. Egress maps and important information will be given to you at the event along with anything included in the package you purchased.
- All vehicles registered and present are automatically entered into the “Airports Top 3” choice award
- This event is Pre-Registration ONLY – you will not be allowed to enter if you are not pre-registered!

Terms & Conditions:

I am not to appear for the event under the influence of any illegal drugs, alcohol or prescription drugs not prescribed to me. I agree to inform the supervisor if taking any over-the-counter or prescription medications which may impair the ability to be present at the event or drive your vehicle.

I will abide by all City/YKM policies regarding personal conduct while performing volunteer services.

I agree not to go beyond the scope of the event agreed to without authorization.

Depending on the scope of the event, the following policies may apply, without limitation: Driving, Safety Procedures, Computer Operation, Dress Code, Anti-Harassment, Confidentiality, Code of Ethics, Workplace Violence Prevention and Drug-Free Workplace. For my safety and that of others, I will comply with the YKM's policies, safety rules and other directions for all activities. I will supervise any child or other person for whom I am responsible. If I become aware of any hazardous condition or danger at a City/YKM facility, I will alert YKM immediately.

I understand that I am to report any injury or illness, no matter how minor, to YKM. I authorize emergency medical care if it should become necessary.

I grant full permission to use any photographs, videotapes, motion pictures or recordings for publicity purposes by the City/YKM.

I hereby identify that I am capable of participating in the event without accommodation, or with the following accommodation(s) (list below)

Alcohol

Alcohol will not be allowed or served on the premise of the event.

Security

A temporary security rope fence will be erected and security officials designated by the Airport Security Coordinators will watch all entrances/exits to ensure personnel and attendees stay within the proper boundaries during the full duration of the event. All person(s) working at your station will need to be on file in this application with the Airport Administration Office and security badges will be issued for this event. In the event an alteration needs to occur to those on file, please notify the Airport Administrative Office immediately. The Yakima Police Department may have a presence at the event. In the event an emergency, contact 911. Official Logo

This contract does not allow any vendor to use the official logo or trademark of the Yakima Air Terminal – McAllister Field Aviation Day and the City of Yakima. A specific request must be made by any vendor desiring to use the logo in the LICENSEE's booth.

Subletting Prohibited

LICENSEE shall not sublet or assign any privilege or portion of the space covered by this agreement.

Termination by Yakima Air Terminal – McAllister Field Aviation Day
Yakima Air Terminal – McAllister Field Aviation Day and the City of Yakima may terminate this agreement and the privilege granted by it (a) at any time Yakima Air Terminal – McAllister Field Aviation Day and the City of Yakima in its sole discretion determines a need for the premises which is inconsistent with use and occupancy by LICENSEE. In this event termination shall occur immediately upon notice to LICENSEE.

Release of Liability

All vendors, their agents, employees, and invitees shall execute a City of Yakima Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk Agreement (“Release”) in the form provided by the Yakima Air Terminal – McAllister Field and the City of Yakima. A copy of the Release is attached hereto as Exhibit B. Without an executed Release(s), this registration shall not be approved and the Vendors, their agents, employees, and invitees shall not be allowed to attend the event.

Consent to Show Rules

By submitting this form, I (the named individual on this application) agree to abide by all airport rules and understand that I am solely responsible for my vehicle, its insurance and securing my own belongings. I further agree to release the City of Yakima, Yakima Air Terminal, the City where the show resides, and all sponsors/vendors from liability for personal injury, loss or property damage. Further, I understand that checking the required boxes on this agreement, that the information I have provided is true and correct, that I understand the requirements of this statement, and this application in its entirety has the same force and effect as my signature would if signed in-person.
